Mr. David Will Play Concerts for Kids in the Pacific Northwest

Mr. David will perform live and play songs from his latest CD, *Mr. David's First Album*, which includes a collection of original tracks and old classics that have been called "creative," "quirky" and full of "superb musicianship."

Mr. David was born and raised in San Jose, Calif. He first picked up a guitar at the age of fourteen, which begot a love for music that has taken him into many different genres and styles. He experiments with and has been influenced by everything from blues to Opera. A dedicated songwriter and guitar player, he is not afraid to play anything, from the piano to conga drum to harmonica and everything in between, to create a sound that will get children moving to music. Mr. David runs a music enrichment program in the Bay Area, which he takes to local preschools, elementary and middle schools.
